3rd EuCheMS Chemistry Congress - Chemistry – the Creative Force August 29 - September 2, 2010, Nürnberg / Germany

The 3rd EuCheMS Chemistry Congress in Nürnberg (Nuremberg) 2010 will present the latest research in the core topic areas of chemistry, feature multidisciplinary programming, and highlight chemistry's impact on society. The congress will bring together chemical and molecular scientists from industry, academia and government institutions across Europe and from around the world.

More than 130 hours of a top class lecture programme will focus on contributions of chemistry to future technologies. The scientific programme and related discussion platforms provide firm ground for networking and a high level professional training. This was previously recognized by relevant industries, and many chemical and related companies support the congress actively via sponsoring. A vendor exhibition will include leading companies showing their latest innovations in chemistry and related fields.

The 3rd EuCheMS Chemistry Congress promises to be the largest chemistry event in Europe in 2010 with more than 3,000 participants. The format and the atmosphere of the congress will tie in with the previous successful conferences in Torino (2008) and Budapest (2006).
