

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER AUTHORS: INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Poster Format and Style Recommendations for Preparation:

Poster-Size A0 portrait format

Width: 84,1 cm (2.76 feet), Height: 118,9 cm (3.87 feet)

Your poster should have a title, author(s) name and affiliation/address to be placed at the top of the poster area (the size of the letters should be minimum 25 mm (1")).

The font size of the poster text should be 1 cm (0.4") high and graph lines should be 1 mm (0.04") minimum.

Poster content should be intelligible in itself, even in the absence of the authors and without a study of the abstract. The poster language is English.

Please structure your poster as follows:

- 1) Title, author(s), affiliation/address
- 2) Introduction
Background information, purpose of study
- 3) Results
- 4) Discussion and conclusion - An interpretation of the results and their significance
References

Poster Board and Mount Information:

Each poster board will be labelled at the upper left corner with the respective poster code number (e.g.: Ia.001 or Vib.001). Please do not remove this label.

Materials to mount the posters will be available at the congress office.

Please do not print on the poster board.

Copies of a summary of your poster content or copies of the entire poster can be posted in the lower right hand corner of the poster board. Alternatively, you can post an envelope to collect reprint requests at this place.

Poster Author's Presence / Poster Session:

The poster session will take place on Tuesday from 20:00 hrs to 22:00 hrs. All poster authors are requested to be in attendance at their poster board at the given time.

Time to mount the poster: 08:00 hrs to 13:00 hrs on Monday, August 30, 2010

Time to remove the poster: 13:00 hrs to 17:00 hrs on Thursday, September 2, 2010

Any remaining poster will be discarded after 17:00 hrs on Thursday (and not stored).
